two-bedroom units at \$147,400 and two-bedroom suites with dens at \$154,400. Maintenance fees are 33 cents per square foot.

Each unit has a patio, balcony or terrace. Suites have ceramic tiles in bathrooms and kitchens, broadloom throughout the rest of the unit and wood cabinetry.

The project is close to shopping, War-

den subway station, a hospital and several parks, Lamb says.

"It's an ideal location for someone with a young family who wants to get started in the market," he says.

Lamb says advance interest in St. Clair Point has been strong, judging by the number of phone calls his company has received.
